PREFACE

The purpose of this By Law is provide a policy on nomination, appointment and allocation of costs of team officials and referees for all SA International Teams. This policy is made pursuant to clause 30 of the SA Constitution.

This Policy confirms that the SA Board has the responsibility of ratifying the appointments of these positions based on recommendations made to the National Office by the National Branch Chairman.

The SA Board believes everyone who is a current member of SA and has met the required qualification and experience has the right to put forward their name as and when nominations are called for. While the appointment of team officials and referees is to be ratified by the SA Board the selection will be based solely on a recommendation received from the National Branch Chairman and based on criteria as set by the National Branch Executive.

Team Officials/Referees

1. Branch Recommendations

- 1.1 A list of all International and National Officials/Referees is to be kept by the respective National Branch Officials Committee Chairman.
- 1.2 The National Branch Officials Committee Chairman shall provide to the National Branch Committee a list of officials, in order of preference for appointment, the names of officials, who meet the requirements to officiate at the international competition, within seven (7) days of being requested to do so by the National Branch Chairman
- 1.3 The National Branch Chairman, after discussion with his/her committee, will recommend to the SA Board, through the National Office, the name/s of the official/referee who should attend the selected international event.

2. Board Appointment

- 2.1 The SA Board will meet within seven (7) days of receipt of the recommendation to consider the recommendations from the National Branch Chairman. This may be via teleconference, email or in person.
- 2.2 The SA Board shall consider the recommendations and may:
 - (a) appoint one of the 2 people recommended by the National Branch Chairman; or
 - (b) if the Board considers that the persons put forward do not have the desired experience or qualifications, the Board may consider and appoint any of the other nominees for the position.

3 Notification

- 3.1 The National Office will notify the National Branch Chairmen of the Board's decision within 24 hours of their reaching their decision.
- 3.2 The successful and unsuccessful applicants will be notified within seven (7) days of the National Branch Chairmen being notified.

4 No right to Appeal

- 4.1 The decision of the SA Board will be final and there shall be no right to appeal.

5 Costs

- 5.1 All costs associated with the Team Official/Referee's travel/accommodation/official team uniform/insurance and meal allowance will be

covered either by the National Branch or by cost share amongst all team members.

- 5.2 SA will advise the Team Official Referee and the National Branch Chairman whether any funds will be provided towards these costs either from SA General Funds, High Performance Grants and/or Qantas Sponsorship within seven (7) days of ratification of the respective team.
