World Skate Oceania advises that the 2019 World Skate Oceania Inline Speed Championships will be hosted by Skate Australia Inc in Brisbane, Australia.

The competition venue is located five (5) minutes from Brisbane International & Domestic Airport in the northern Brisbane suburb of Nundah at the Albert Bishop Park Criterium Track situated at Hedley Avenue, Nundah. Racing circuit is 410m with the 1.2km circuit used for marathon events.

The Championships are open to skaters from all countries affiliated to World Skate. Approval letter from national federations for international skaters must accompany nominations.

Dates: 19 to 24 April 2019  
Training: Friday 19 and Saturday 20 April  
Competition: Sunday 21 and Monday 22 April  
Rest/Rain Day: Tuesday 23 April  
Marathon and Presentations: Wednesday 24 April



Brisbane: Brisbane, capital of Queensland, is a large city on the Brisbane River. Clustered in its South Bank cultural precinct are the Queensland Museum and Science Centre, with noted interactive exhibitions. **Judges:** Federations are invited to nominate judges. Skate Australia Inc regrets that it is unable to fund such officials.

**Entry Fees:** AU \$130.00 per skater.

**Accommodation**

**and Travel:** Travel and Accommodation are the responsibility of participating skaters/judges/officials and/or their respective National Federations. Should your team require assistance to find accommodation within a reasonable distance to the competition venue, please let us know.

**Trophies:** Trophies and/or medals will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> places with all competitors and officials receiving a souvenir certificate of participation.

**Sanction:** The championship will be conducted with sanctions from World Skate and its sub-committees and the host national federation.

**Authorised Officials:** Authorised Team Officials may apply for a free season pass, which will be supplied to Team, no more than one [1] team manager, one [1] team coach, one [1] assistant team manager OR one [1] assistant team coach OR one [1] team chaperone and one [1] team doctor [medically qualified person eg doctor, physiotherapist] for speed.

**Closing Date:** All entries close at midnight on **28 February 2019**.

**Nomination:** All entries must be provided by each Federation via the Event Registration link: <https://www.revolutionise.com.au/skate/events/34857/> Passports and Anti-Doping Registration Forms to be uploaded with registration. **Anti Doping Control:** Anti-doping control will be carried out in accordance with FIRS Medical Regulations.

**Competitors:** Each Federation shall use its own method to select the team it enters for the competition. Teams selected for competition at the Oceania Speed Championships shall be the official Team of the country they are representing.
